

Objective

SeaTurtle Sports Bag Toss game challenges two to four players to score in three holes of different sizes, with the highest points awarded to tosses that land in the smallest hole. Rounds are played until a player or team reaches 21 points and wins the game.

Set Up and Play

The target boards work best on flat and soft surfaces like grass or sand. Place the boards 20 to 30 feet apart or at a convenient distance. Assign a bean bag color to each player or team. Winner of a coin toss throws first.

In singles the two opponents toss all bags from the same board, walk to the target board and score the round. Then reverse direction and play toward the other target board, repeating the process until the game is complete.

In team play, opposing players stand at one board and take turns throwing their bags to the opposite board where teammates are waiting to score the round. Those players then begin play in the opposite direction. **Airmail** A bean bag lands directly in the hole

A bean bas on to drow hole

Jumper

A bean bag that strikes another bag on the board causing it to jump into a hole

Bouncer
A bean bag that
hits the board and
bounces into a hole

A player may toss the bags from either the right or left side of board, but in any one round all bags must be tossed from the same side and without stepping across the plane at the front of the board. In singles or team play, players alternate, tossing one bag at a time until all the bags have been thrown.

The last team to score in the prior round begins the next round. If no team scores the team that tossed last would toss first.

The rounds continue until one player or team reaches 21 points, although any agreed upon total is acceptable.

In the event of a tie, rounds continue until the tie is broken and one player or team wins the game.

Scoring

Points Awarded:

Top hole 3 pts
Middle hole 2 pts
Bottom hole 1 pt

Points are not awarded for bags hanging into a hole on the target board, bags landing on the board or bags missing the target board altogether.
